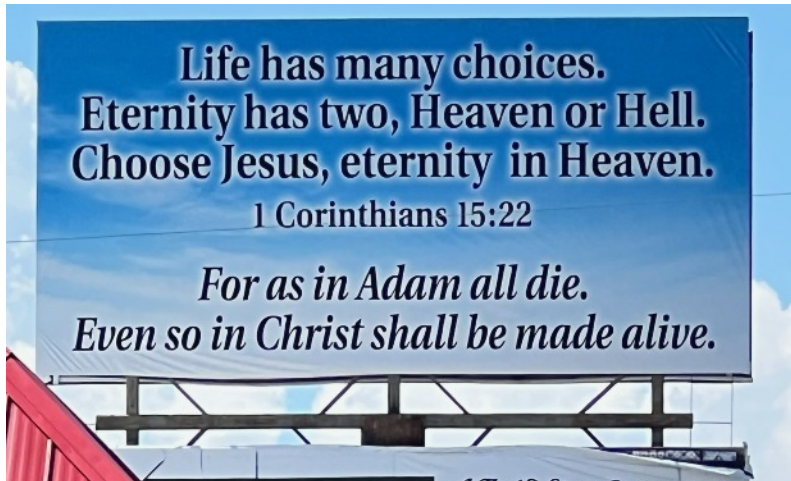

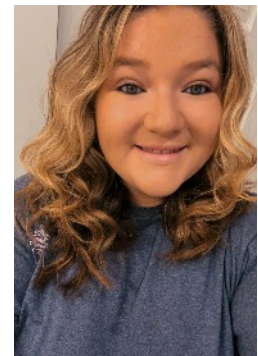

Casey County Baptist Association (CCBA) has been serving the community since 2005. Over the years, we have provided the community with clothing items. Our sister churches offer a wide variety of services for homes and individuals alike.

Below is a brief history of how our association came into being.

The South District Association was formed in 1785 and included Baptist churches from Boyle, Casey, Garrard, Marion, and Washington counties. In 2005, the Casey County Baptist Association was reorganized and became its own association for the first time in over 200 years. At that time, the office began operating out of the back of one of the 12 churches in the association.

In 2008, the Casey County Baptist Mission Center was established when one of the churches closed down. The remaining members of the church generously donated the church building, parsonage, kitchen/classroom building, and surrounding land to the CCBA for any necessary use.

The CCBA members are enthusiastic about the organization's growth and expansion, and eagerly anticipate how God will use them to impact the county, state, and the world.

Pray for our kids who are growing up that their world will be a much better time than the present. Our world is changing at an unprecedented pace. The world we lived in last year is not the same as the world we live in today, and it will be different again next year.
